RxPrices Better at Online Canadian Pharmacies Than Amazon, GoodRx or Traditional Pharmacies

New Price Comparison finds greatest prescription drug savings at certified online Canadian pharmacies over traditional pharmacies, GoodRx or AmazonPharmacy. The new analysis released by the Campaign for Personal Prescription Importation (CPPI) found that, even with coupon discounts at leading U.S. pharmacy competitors, prescription drugs are on average 50% to 90% cheaper from licensed online Canadian pharmacies.

Opposition to HHS Wholesale Importation Rule Grows; Send A Message



There is increasing opposition to a "Final Rule" issued by the U.S. Health and Human Services (HHS) on importation. The rule threatens to deny access to the personal importation of critical medications that millions of American lives depend on, and could increase the costs of imported drugs.

The new HHS regulatory rule that took effect on November 30, could block American access to personal

prescription importation denying Americans their medications and the savings they depend on.

On Friday, November 27, the <u>Canadian government</u> joined <u>CPPI</u> and a course of voices saying that the new HHS regulation is no good. Canadian health minister Patty Hajdu announced new measures to protect the country's drug supply from the hasty HHS regulation and bulk importations that could worsen drug shortages.



U.S. Senators Debbie Stabenow and Gary Peters sent a letter to HHS expressing their own concerns that the Final Importation Rule would have negative impacts on Americans who depend on personal importation for access to critical medications at affordable prices.
